Dear Returning Players:

The volunteer board at Lethbridge Minor Football, comprised of the four (4) head coaches and one (1) member at large; have opted to revamp the registration process for 2010 and we hope it will even further add to your already great football experience.

Registration:

Monday, May 3, 2010 6:00-8:00 pm. - Returning players and their siblings ONLY (not friends, neighbours nor cousins)

Monday, May 3, 2010 – 6:00-8:00 pm. -Registered (with proof of registration) prospective Summer Games players, who will be playing in the Bantam program with Lethbridge Minor Football in the fall of 2010 – (all prospective Summer Games players that will be entering a High School football program in the fall, should contact their respective High School team for equipment).

Saturday, June 12, 2010 – 10:00 am – 2:00 pm Returning players and new players

Monday, August 23, 2010 – 6:00 pm – 7:00 pm Returning players and new players

Monday, August 30, 2010 – 6:00 pm – 7:00 pm Returning players and new players

Refund Policy - should a player quit prior to the 1st game, ½ of the registration fee will be refunded. Should a player be injured prior to the 1st game, all but \$25 will be refunded (with a Dr's note stating further play is not possible))

Volunteer Requirements for 2010:

As mentioned, the board is comprised of volunteer members, who have, in the interest of ensuring the continuance of LMFA, decided that we need your help. Each player will be required to contribute either 1 hour of volunteer work (either personally or through his or her parent) or pay an additional \$40 on their registration fee (if \$40 is paid prior to hour worked, \$40 will be returned).

There are many opportunities to complete your 1 hour of volunteer time, starting with the need for:

36 volunteers at registration on May 3rd. (12 from 5:30 – 6:30, 12 from 6:30 – 7:30 and 12 from 7:30 – 8:30). Choices range from 4 Helmet fitters, 2 shoulder pad fitters, 1 weight scale attendant, 4 registration table attendants and 1 knee, tail and thigh pad attendant. All equipment fittings will be under the supervision of the 4 head coaches. Assignments will be granted on a first come first served basis at lmfavolunteer@gmail.com

There are additional volunteer requirements:

Following each registration, data entry to Football Alberta is required. This task can be completed from 8:00 pm – 9:00 pm (May 3rd) again from 2:00 pm – 3:00 pm (June 12), again from 7:00 pm – 8:00 pm (August 23), again from 7:00 pm – 8:00 pm (August 30) following registration, at a data entry lab containing 4 computers (therefore 4 volunteers would be great).

60 volunteers at registration on June 12th. (12 from 9:30 –10:30, 12 from 10:30 –11:30, 12 from 11:30 – 12:30, 12 from 12:30 – 1:30 and 12 from 1:30 – 2:30). Choices range from 4 Helmet fitters, 2 shoulder pad fitters, 1 weight scale attendant, 4 registration table attendants and 1 knee, tail and thigh pad attendant.

14 volunteers at registration on August 23, 2010 (. (7 from 5:30 –6:30, 7 from 6:30 –7:30). Choices range from 2 Helmet fitters, 1 shoulder pad fitters, 1 weight scale attendant, 2 registration table attendants and 1 knee, tail and thigh pad attendant.

14 volunteers at registration on August 30, 2010 (initial letter stated August 23 – sorry) (7 from 5:30 – 6:30, 7 from 6:30 –7:30). Choices range from 2 Helmet fitters, 1 shoulder pad fitters, 1 weight scale attendant, 2 registration table attendants and 1 knee, tail and thigh pad attendant.

The need for the assembly of 5 helmet storage racks. Racks are located at Vazari Storage and take approximately 1 hour to assemble.

As you can see, before the season has even started, 145 man/woman hours of volunteer time is required. In addition,

We need for timeclock operators for each of the Bantam and Junior Varsity games (split into 2 – 1 hour shifts for each Bantam game) and 1 full, 1 hour shift at the JV games.

The coaches need someone who will:

Create a group e-mail list for each division (Bantam, JV, PW and Atom) of their team.

Create a listing of Uniform numbers assigned

Create an emergency contact listing, including know medical conditions

Create a game listing, including Uniform # (please sort by uniform #), position, name, for the benefit of the game announcer (which LMFA has deemed to be important and one is being hired)

And further assignments as determined by each head coach (the head coaches will in turn report completed volunteer hours through lmfavolunteer@gmail.com and refunds will be issued.)

Thanks so very much to all who have volunteered in the past and a very warm welcome to all who choose to volunteer in 2010. We truly appreciate your commitment to your child.

Just a reminder that LMFA does not currently have any boundaries and your child is entitled to register for whichever team meets his/her (and of course your) requirements.

To anyone wishing to apply for **Kidsport** this year; please ensure you make your application as soon as possible. Any of the 4 head coaches are authorized to approve your registration, thereby alleviating

you being required to pay up front, as Kidsport may have you approved and have already contacted us with your approval prior to you being required to register.
